

Busking Policy

1. Nature of performance
 - 1.1. Buskers may perform material of any style or genre.
 - 1.2. The use of amplification is permitted within reasonable limits.
 - 1.2.1. The busker must reduce the volume of amplification if requested by any Guild staff member or Disciplinary Officer.
 - 1.3. The content of the performance must comply with the Student Charter of Rights and Responsibilities, the Statutes of the University, and the Statutes of the Student Guild.
 - 1.3.1. Violation of 1.3 is grounds for revocation of the busking permit under 3.2.
 - 1.3.2. Prohibited content includes, but is not limited to:
 - 1.3.2.1. Sexist material;
 - 1.3.2.2. Racist material;
 - 1.3.2.3. Material which may be considered otherwise offensive or indecent for public performance.
 - 1.4. Buskers may not advertise any goods or services, excluding:
 - 1.4.1. Events approved by the UWA Student Guild Events Office;
 - 1.4.2. Events featuring the busker as a performing artist.
 - 1.5. Buskers may not sell any goods or services, excluding:
 - 1.5.1. Recordings of the busker;
 - 1.5.2. Tickets to an event featuring the busker as a performing artist;
 - 1.5.3. Other merchandise as approved by the UWA Student Guild Events Office.
 - 1.6. All money generated from busking is considered the property of the busker.
2. Location
 - 2.1. A busker shall not perform in the same location for more than one hour, notwithstanding
 - 2.1.3, after which time the busker:
 - 2.1.1. must move at least twenty (20) metres from the initial location
 - 2.1.2. Cannot return to, or be within twenty (20) metres of, the initial location
 - 2.1.3. As long as there are no other buskers waiting to use the location in question, then a busker may choose to continue indefinitely.
 - 2.2. There may not be two or more buskers within:
 - 2.2.1. Twenty (20) metres of each other; or
 - 2.2.2. Such distance that the buskers may be considered to interfere with each other
 - 2.3. A busker may be asked to move at any time by a member of Guild staff, Disciplinary Officer or UWA Security.
 - 2.4. Buskers are only allowed within the Guild Village Precinct
 - 2.5. Buskers must not obstruct doorways or the passage of pedestrians
3. Permit
 - 3.1. A busking permit may be obtained through application to the Events Officer
 - 3.2. A Busking permit may be revoked at any time, by the discretion of the Events Officer
 - 3.3. A busker must present his/her permit upon the request of any Guild staff member or Disciplinary Officer
 - 3.4. Nobody may busk in the Guild Village Precinct without a busking permit
 - 3.5. Buskers who are not Guild Members may be required to pay for a permit, at a price to be determined by the Guild Executive.
