- 14.1 The 112th Guild Council:
- **14.1.1** Condemns the Albanese Labor Government, Cook Labor State Government and Environment Minister Murray Watt for the extension of Woodside's North West Shelf gas project, which will have severe climate, ecological, and cultural impacts, despite Labor's stated commitment to the climate and net zero.
- 14.1.2 Recognises that Woodside's North West Shelf fails to uphold indigenous rights and cultural heritage, in contravention of United Nations Convention and condemns the governments refusal to undertake adequate consultation with Traditional Owners including Murujuga Custodians. Calls for the immediate protection of over one million pieces of ancient Murujuga rock art that is being destroyed due to greenhouse gas emissions causing acidification to the rocks
